Francis Xavier here. (How, I love speaking with you guys!)

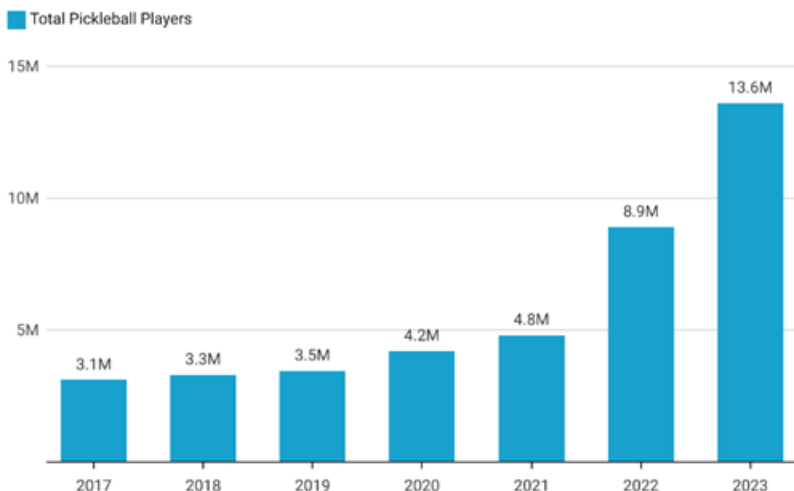
